

(b) In the Schedule the following footnotes shall be inserted, namely :—

"Note I.—The prescribed experience shall be counted after acquiring the required basic educational qualifications, unless otherwise specified in the rules.

Note II.—Eligibility of candidates shall be reckoned as on the closing date fixed for the submission of application in accordance with Recruitment Rules and the instructions of the Government and the FPSC".

O. 697 (I)/93.—In pursuance of sub-rule (2) of rule 3 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973, the following method, qualifications and other conditions are laid down for appointment to the following BPS-16 posts in the Federal Services Hospital under the Health Division :—

- (i) Superintendent.
- (ii) Accountant.
- (iii) Assistant Nursing Superintendent.
- (iv) Head Nurse.
- (v) Assistant Physiotherapist.

METHOD OF APPOINTMENT

2. The posts mentioned above shall be filled by promotion and failing that by transfer.

CONDITIONS FOR PROMOTION

3. Promotion to the posts in column 2 below shall be made by selection from amongst the persons who hold the posts specified in column 3 on a regular

basis and possess the qualifications and experience prescribed in column 4:—

QUALIFICATIONS/CONDITIONS FOR TRANSFER

4. Appointment by transfer shall be made from amongst the persons holding appointment on a regular basis in the same basic pay scale in which the post to be filled exists provided the person concerned possesses the qualifications/experience prescribed for promotion to the post concerned.

PROBATION

5. Persons appointed by promotion or transfer shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded or if considered necessary, it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of section 6 of Civil Servants Act, 1973, read with the rule 21 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973.

6. This Notification issues with the concurrence of the Establishment Division vide O.M. No. F. 11-4/89-R-5, dated 29th July, 1993 and supersedes the existing recruitment rules of BPS-16 posts in the Federal Government Services Hospital, Islamabad.
