S. R. O. 789-(I)/99.—In pursuance of sub-rule (2) of Rule 3 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973 the following method, qualifications and other conditions are laid down for appointment to the post of Physiotherapist (PBS-20) in the Federal Government Services Hospital, Islamabad, under the Ministry of Health:—

METHOD OF APPOINTMENT

2. Initially the post shall be filled by promotion of the incumbent of the post of Physiotherapist (BPS-19) and thereafter the post shall be filled as under:—

S. No.	Designations and BPS of the posts	By promotion	By initial appointment
1.	Physiotherapist (BS-20).	—	100%

Provided that failing initial appointment the post shall be filled by transfer.

CONDITIONS FOR PROMOTION

3. Promotion to the post in column 2 below shall be made by selection from amongst the persons who hold the post specified in column-3 on a regular basis and fulfil the conditions prescribed in column-4:—

(i) M.Sc. in Physiotherapy of equivalent.

(ii) 17 years service in BS 17 and above.

5 years service in BS-19.

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QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMITS FOR INITIAL
APPOINTMENT

4. A candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age limits as mentioned against the post concerned in the schedule to this Notification. In these Rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context :—

(i) "Experience" means the experience gained in a regular full time paid job after obtaining the prescribed basic qualifications.

(ii) The period spent by a candidate in obtaining degree of M. Phil or Ph.D in the relevant field shall be treated as practical experience upto a maximum period of two and four years respectively for the purpose of initial appointment, provided that :

(a) A candidate who has obtained the degree of M. Phil or Ph.D during service shall not be entitled to a double benefit of counting the said period as service towards experience prescribed for the post ; and

(b) This concession shall not be available for the post for which the prescribed qualification is M. Phil or Ph. D.

(iii) The maximum age limits will be relaxed upto the age of 55 years wherever applicable for appointment to all posts under the Federal Government as provided in S. R. O. No. 1079 (I)/93, dated 4th December, 1993.

(iv) Eligibility of candidates shall be reckoned as on the closing date fixed for submission of applications in accordance with the Recruitment Rules and the Instructions issued by the Government and the Federal Public Service Commission from time to time.

QUALIFICATIONS|CONDITIONS FOR APPOINTMENT BY TRANSFER

5. Appointment by transfer shall be made from ~~amongst~~ the persons holding appointment under the Federal Government on a regular basis in the same basic pay scale in which the post to be filled exists, provided the person concerned possesses the qualifications|experience prescribed for initial appointment to the post concerned.

PROBATION

6. Persons appointed by initial appointment, promotion or transfer shall be on probation for a period one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded or if consider necessary, it may be extended for

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a period not exceeding one year as may be specified at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of section 6 of Civil Servants Act, 1973.

7. This Notification issues with the concurrence of the Establishment Division vide O.M. No. 11/2/88-R-5, dated 16th June, 1999 and FPSC vide their letter No. F. 15-10/98-S, dated 2nd June, 1999 and supersedes this Ministry's Notification No. S.R.O. 1203 (I)/80, dated 29th November, 1980 concerning Recruitment Rules for the post of Physiotherapist (BPS-19).
